



COVID-19 Housing Court Information

New York City Housing Court is currently open for emergency cases permitted by the court, including if you are locked out of your home without a court order, if you need emergency repairs, or if you need critical services like heat or hot water. Emergency cases can be started electronically or over the phone and you can appear without coming to a court building.

Most other matters, including regular appearances in housing court, will be rescheduled by the court, and parties will be notified by postcard.
